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The Role of Islamic Ethics in Raising the Spirituality of Youth in the Time of Innovative Changes

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ABSTRACT

The article analyzes the role of Islamic ethics in raising the spirituality of young people during the current innovative changes and the development of Uzbekistan. In covering this issue, he used as a methodological source the comments on the topic in the address of the President of Uzbekistan, Shovkat Mirziyoyev, to the Oliy Majlis on December 22, 2017. The holy sources of Islam, the Holy Qur'an, and Hadith, as well as Islamic philosophy, especially the theory of imagination, served as a theoretical source for explaining and clarifying the issues related to the topic.

In the process of globalization and innovative changes, as well as spiritual growth, it is necessary to use all means effectively and efficiently to bring the spiritual world of our youth to higher levels. This is with the goal of effective use of modern scientific achievements, literature, art, religious values, computer technologies, mass media, newspapers, magazines, television, radio, and Internet pages. Among these, it is also possible to make appropriate use of Islamic ethics and Islamic teachings, which are one of our spiritual values.

Now, to find out how Islam serves this topic, the holy book of this religion and the programming of Muslims were inadvertently used. We will pay attention to the "Holy Qur'an" and hadith. In the religion of Islam, attention to knowledge and the level of scholars have always been of high status.

For example, in the first revealed verse of the Qur'an, Allah Almighty says: "Read (begin) with the name of our Lord, the Creator." He created man from clotted blood (3 months)

Read on! Your Lord is the Most Substantial One who taught (mankind) the pen (i.e. the life to write). He will teach man what he does not know.

In the Arabic recitation of this verse, the word "iqra" is read first. From this verse, Allah the Exalted informs the verses that, "In the period after the revelation of the Qur'an, the factor leading to the advancement of human spirituality is reading, that is, learning knowledge." Indeed, we know from history that from the centuries after Islam to the present day, science has been making great progress. Prophet Muhammad (AS) said in his hadith, "The example of a person who learns knowledge in his youth is like a pattern engraved on a stone, and the example of a person who learns his knowledge in old age is like writing on water."

They also said, "Be a guardian of science like a shepherd, but don't be just a narrator of science." From this hadith, one can understand how important it is to acquire knowledge at a young age and apply it in practice. The same thing is emphasized in this hadith, "Know my youth as a treasure before old age comes." That is, youth is a very short and fleeting period. We must make the most of this fleeting moment of our lives. Sirriy Sahati, who is one of the mature scholars, says. "O youth team! Act because the action is in youth. They are telling us the real truth in their wisdom that this person is engaged in science throughout his life, and the best time to learn from his experiences and apply them in experiments is youth. In fact, among our youth, many people are eager for knowledge, but most of them can't find it. Khasan Basri, a scholar who lived in the 7th-8th centuries, says the following to such of us: "O youth community! Avoid procrastinating by saying, "I will do it soon"! and they say, "Yesterday is over, you don't know what tomorrow will be like, so you only have today, use it!" With these words of wisdom, Hassan Basri is calling to appreciate the time. It is well known that time is a continuous and passing process. Our youth should pay serious attention to this simple fact. Scholars say: "When there is an opportunity, learn knowledge, but when knowledge is necessary, there is no opportunity." This quality should be a program for our youth.

Each of our young men and women should understand the meaning of this wisdom and make

good use of the opportunity to learn. At this time, it is necessary to remember an important issue. There are some misunderstandings among people about the knowledge mentioned in verses and hadiths. Some people say: "There are some people who want to understand about the knowledge mentioned in the verses and hadiths. Some say: "The knowledge mentioned in the verses and hadiths includes useful knowledge. In the teaching of Islam, religious sciences are definitely in the first place. However, it is completely wrong to say that other sciences are not considered. If the verses and hadiths only refer to religious knowledge, this would be noted separately. For example, it is said in the hadith, "Whoever Allah sees good in, He makes him a faqih in religion." When talking about other similar Islamic sciences, their names and qualities are also mentioned. Therefore, the knowledge mentioned in the Qur'an and hadith are all useful sciences.

Now let's look directly at the foundations of Islamic ethics. We believe that it is worth quoting the following comments of Anvar Khojiakhmad, the translator of the book "Islamic Ethics" by the famous Turkish theologian Abdurahman Qaya.

Islamic morals based on the blessed verses of the Holy Qur'an and the hadiths of Muhammad Mustafa, the leader of the world, have educated several generations in the spirit of the noblest human qualities, and have steadily cultivated high universal values such as goodness, social justice, mutual harmony, brotherhood, and kindness, humanity, humaneness. came to the ceremony. These qualities are still one of the priority factors of our spirituality." 4

Citizens elect government officials who run the affairs of the country. Electing good people to the government or parliament during elections and participating in elections and voting is one of our duties to the country and the nation.

Above, when it comes to duties, it was not for nothing noted that paying the taxes demanded by the government is an important duty of citizenship.

In modern Uzbekistan, our state and government pay great attention to business activities. The number of our honest, brave, truly patriotic entrepreneurs is increasing year by year. They pay the required taxes on their income on time and regularly
